We understand that .kids could be a possible global generic Top-Level Domain (gTLD) under the new gTLD application program. Since the ".kids" platform may have a great impact on children worldwide, we as a part of the NGO community concerning the well-being of children, therefore hope that the future .kids registry could follow the below guiding principles:

- Adopt the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) as a fundamental guiding principle to protect the rights of children;
